#### The Emmaus School of Biblical Studies 2016-2017 school year!

The Emmaus School of Biblical Studies is a 10-month discipleship school held on the campus of Canterbury Retreat & Conference Center in Oviedo, FL. The school takes students on a journey through the content of the entire Bible utilizing the tools of Inductive Bible Study to thoroughly observe the scriptures, interpret them within the historical and literary context, and apply the truths of Scripture to their real, everyday lives.

There are three ways to engage in this journey during the upcoming 2016-2017 school year:

- 1) **On-Campus Residential** (cost: \$8950): Live with a community of disciples on the campus of Canterbury. This cost includes housing, utilities, tuition and meals for the entire 10-months.
- 2) **Commuter Student** (cost: \$4500): For local students with off-campus housing, commuter students participate in the full Emmaus school including the provision of one-meal Monday-Friday.
- 3) **Audit Program** (cost: \$25/book OR \$450 for a full-year pass): A great way for people in the area who desire to join the Emmaus classroom and grow in their understanding of the Scriptures.

On-Campus & Commuter students are encouraged to apply for the Youth Ministry Internship opportunity which provides them with practical ministry experience in a local parish as well as a \$1000 tuition discount.
