THEOLOGICAL REFLECTION

If you are ordained as deacon and priest you will promise: “I solemnly declare that I do believe the Holy Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments to be the Word of God, and to contain all things necessary to salvation.” **What does this promise mean to you and how does it inform your ministry?**

In your baptism you promised to “accept Jesus Christ as your savior,” to “trust in his grace and love” and to “follow and obey him as your Lord.” If you are ordained you will promise: “I do solemnly engage to conform to the doctrine, discipline, and worship of the Episcopal Church.” **How do you understand these two promises in relationship to one another?**


