Padre Jose is the co-Rector at Christ the King and the Vicar at Jesus de Nazaret. He serves diverse congregations uniting them in one witness to our one Lord. He has mentored multiple individuals with discerning vocations. Under his leadership, the congregations have sponsored many deacons and priests now serving in and outside our diocese.

He and the congregations have ministered to thousands. Their work with displaced and marginalized persons is well-known and recognized. It includes hunger relief, vocational rehabilitation, public health initiatives, and an expanding youth program in partnership with the State of Florida.

He has served as Alternate Deputy and then Deputy at the past two General Conventions. He has supported the work of our Diocese and Bishop and served on committees and working groups. He also authored, co-authored, and supported many resolutions that have passed.

Many of his authored and co-authored resolutions have directly supported our partners in Province IX. These resolutions have supported equity and parity in ministry for the laity and underrepresented groups in discernment processes.

He is well-known and respected in many parts of the church. He is part of the leadership of Deputies of Color and was recently invited to speak at the joint Diocesan Convention of the Dioceses of Eastern and Western Michigan. He is a researcher at the University of Florida and the University of Texas at Austin. He holds an MBA, his doctoral dissertation focused on human migration and demographic change, and he completed a master's focused on Latino Anglicanism.
